






-STATE OF THE NATION-




Round 1 (Elimination Round)

1. The registered participants will receive a background guide which will acquaint the participants with the topic elected for the Bill.
2. After scrutinizing the topic, the participants are required to submit a write up of not more than 200 words sharing their field of vision on the topic by a specified date.
3. Based on the entries submitted, the participants will be selected for Round 2.

Round 2

1. Qualifying teams will be allotted real life political parties and representatives of the Nation which will be based partly on the write-up and partly on the discretion of the organizer.
2. The final draft of the Bill which will be debated upon in the House will be mailed to the participants 6 days prior to the event and the participants would be asked to propose certain amendments, if any.
3. The mentioned draft will further be confabulated and debated upon on the final day in the House.
4. On the basis of the debate among various party representatives, the Bill will further be passed or rejected in the House.

GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS:


- The participants are requested to dress up like their representative politicians.



- STOCK SHOCK -

Stock Shock is the name of the game and uncertainty are its rules. **"Much of our trading comes down to a battle between our patience and impulses."** - Steve Burns. Synergy 21' invites you to experience what it's like to make adrenaline rushed decisions, rely on latent information, and take part in an interplay of your satiability and emotions as you navigate the world of the stock market.




Round 1 (Elimination Round)

This will be an elimination round in which all the participants have to take a 30 min pen paper test consisting of 50 objective questions relating to financial market, financial literacy and investment and trading skills.

Round 2 (Mock Stock)

1. Round 2 of the event is a mock event in which the actual picture of trading, broking, news flow, company quarter results, settlements, consultants will be summarized.
2. Participants clearing the elimination round will be selected for the second and the final round.
3. The participants will now be professional traders and will be buying and selling the stocks and other trading instruments from the brokers directly or indirectly with the help of financial advisors.
4. This round will be of 2 hours.
5. Participants will be given virtual cash of 50 lakhs.
6. 3 types of investment and trading markets will be available to the participants to trade and invest:
 - Equity market- There will be 4 sectors available to the participants for example information technology, energy, banking etc. Each sector will include equity stocks of companies to trade upon.

Round 2 (Mock Stock)

- Debt market- This will include some instruments like securities and/or bonds offering a fixed interest rate and a certain maturity period. Other rules and regulations of individual securities will be revised at the particular moment.
 - Commodity market and forex market- This will be including currencies for example Indian Rupee, New Zealand Dollar, Chinese Yuan, Russian Rubble and commodities like silver, zinc etc in which the participants can make their trade.
7. The price will fluctuate on the basis of news flow and demand & supply mechanism. Trading process will be carried out by the brokers and the brokerage will be charged w.r.t the transaction amount.
 8. The participants will be provided with 1 sheet; brokers will be recording all the transactions in the sheet and would be provide their assent in order to validate the transaction.
 9. Pre - open session will be there at the start of round 2 for a period of 15 minutes and thereafter the event would continue with dynamic news inflows regarding various forms of market. There will be a news flow in every 2 min and its price effect will be announced after 1 min of the announcement.



- STOCK SHOCK -



GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS:

- If the participant makes a transaction in a particular stock, commodity, then any transaction in the same by that participant will only be done after 4 min of the previous transaction.
- The slot for charging brokerage in order to transact a transaction would be between 3%(Maximum) to 1%(Minimum). The participant can bargain the brokerage with the broker in the respective range only.
- For debt instruments, the brokerage is fixed at 1%. If the participant wants to sell their holdings of bonds or securities before the maturity period, the load will be charged at 2%.
- Short sell can only be done in equity and commodity markets. The participants can take help of the financial consultants available regarding the trends in the market as they will be equipped with the charts and facts of stocks and other trading instruments.
- An advantage would be given to top 3 participants clearing the elimination round in the credit limit.

GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS:

- It is mandatory to utilize your full trading amount. The winner will be decided on the basis of the maximum profits not the minimum trade and maximum cash.
- The round will be based on how actual Indian financial market reacted in the last 4 quarters (not the financial year).

Judgement Criteria

- Each participant should have at least 20 overall transactions and 2 transactions done from each sector but 3 transactions in commodity market and forex market.
- The total traded amount should not exceed 50 lakhs.
- In the end, if the entry for short sell is not justified than the transaction will be considered invalid and a penalty of 20% will be imposed on the amount of share or commodity used for short sell.








Round 1

The participants will be sent a common topic 7 days prior to the event through the official mail. They will have to prepare a 1-minute video speaking in favor of the topic and the video needs to be sent within 3 days. The topic may not be ethical or politically correct but the participants need to defend the statement irrespective of their personal thoughts regarding the same.

Round 2

1. Each participant will be asked to choose a random number between 1-25.
2. Participants will get a topic that is associated with their number and they have to defend that topic.
3. Each participant will get only 10 minutes to prepare for their argument.
4. Paper reading is not allowed but participants can take down notes.
5. Each participant will get 2 minutes for the opening speech.
6. After the opening speech the judge will ask them 1 or 2 questions regarding their topic.
7. The questioning round will be followed by the closing statement by the participant.

8. The participants will be judged on the following criteria:

1. Creativity and novelty of thought.
2. Clarity and organization of content.
3. Presentation - tone, modulation, and gestures.
4. Ability/Art of persuasion and fluency.


Round 2 (Physical and Mental Tasks)

2. Participants will take part individually but depending on the rounds they will be randomly grouped based on the task.
3. After round 1, the event will take a turn; politics, alliances, and vote outs.
4. Other subtle nuances of the event will be disclosed on the spot.
5. But hey, let's keep something for the day itself. All further details will be revealed then and there. So, put your seatbelt on and join us in this extraordinary journey.

- Rules are subject to change.



Round 1: The Quest


1. This written elimination round consists of questions which will test your brain cells at every level.





7. Further details of each round will be provided on the spot.





1. This is a team event. Each team will consist of 4 members.






Round 1

Round 2

1. The teams selected in the first round will progress to the second round.

Round 2

2. The teams are required to present a Google Slides/ PowerPoint presentation during this round. Their presentation must consist of the name of the disorder, signs & symptoms, causal factors (from the biopsychosocial approach), treatment, and inspiration for the disorder.
3. Presentations should be approximately 5 minutes.
4. The teams will be judged on knowledge/content, creativity, originality, and clarity and delivery.

Round 3

1. After the second round, each team will be randomly allotted (through chit-picking) another team whose idea they must criticize.
2. After the chit-picking, the participants will be given a 10-minute break to prepare their arguments.
3. The teams will be invited to constructively criticize the ideas of other teams. Each team will also be given the chance to defend themselves. The order in which the teams are given the floor to present their criticism will be random (also through chit-picking).

Round 3

4. Each team will be given 2 minutes to criticize the ideas of the team allotted to them. Then the opposition team will have 1 minute to defend their ideas in response.
5. Participants may only speak when the moderator allows them to. What one participant speaks will represent the whole team.
6. Use of profanity, vulgar mannerism, disrespectful/hate comments during the round will lead to disqualification.
7. Teams will be judged based on their participation, speaking and communication skills, and knowledge/content. The scores for Rounds 2 and 3 will be added to determine the winner and runner-up.
8. The winner and runner-up will be announced in the closing ceremony of the event.


